



Anti-Discrimination Policy

The Community Foundation of Dunn County (CFDC) believes that equal opportunity is important for the continuing success of its organization. In accordance with state, federal, and municipal laws, this Foundation intends to comply with these laws which precludes discrimination because of race, disability, color, creed, religion, gender, age, sexual orientation, national origin, ancestry, citizenship, military status, or any other protected classification.

This policy applies to all activities of the Community Foundation of Dunn County, including but not limited to employment, selection of volunteers, grant making, purchasing, and selecting vendors or consultants. The Community Foundation defines "discrimination" to include (but not necessarily be limited to) denial of services, employment, or volunteer opportunities to any class of individuals in a manner that negatively restricts opportunities to that class of individuals.
